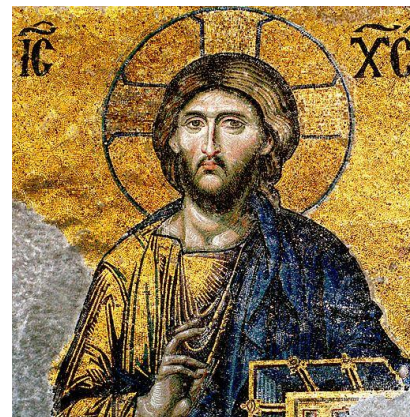
**Brown November Mass Envelopes** for deceased loved ones are available for collection in the Church porch. Please place in the basket in front of the altar
